

Employment Opportunities – Cable Installer

SUMMARY: This associate is responsible for the neat and efficient installation of data/ voice cabling (CAT 3-6), RF cabling required for video, copper, and fiber optic cabling. The Installer is responsible for testing cable installations for compliance with industry standards, and works under the direction of the Installation Supervisor and/or Team Leader. They also ensure that all installations comply with industry, manufacturer and company standards.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for efficient installation of data, voice, and video cabling pulling and placement
- Ensure installation standards compliance on all cabling projects.
- Must have a working knowledge of cable and cable terminals.
- Must be able to perform basic splicing (training will be provided).
- Cable pathways, cable suspension systems
- Responsible for accurate and timely reporting of production progress and inventory usage
- Must maintain a professional image
- Must support and participate in promotion of Company products.
- Must have working computer knowledge in a Windows based environment
- Must be able to work under pressure, handle stress and follow directions.
- Must perform any other duties assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance.
- Familiarity with structured cabling standards and able to incorporate them into customer installations
- Working knowledge of TIA/EIA 568A/B wiring standards and assembly for: 66 blocks, 110 blocks, RJ11, RJ45 jacks, Coaxial and fiber-optic wiring.
- Solid knowledge of color code when punching down voice or data lines as required.
- Capable of using hand tools such as cable strippers, soldering irons, and cable connector crimpers...etc.
- Must be physically fit to perform job (must be able to lift 80 lbs)
- Telecommunications wiring color-code competency.
- Must demonstrate basic computer knowledge in a Windows environment
- Must be able to work shifts, days, nights, evenings (depending on tour selection) and work overtime and emergency call outs.
- Education/Training Preferred:
 - Minimum High Scholl education or equivalent

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- 1-3 years of experience in cabling installations, a plus.
